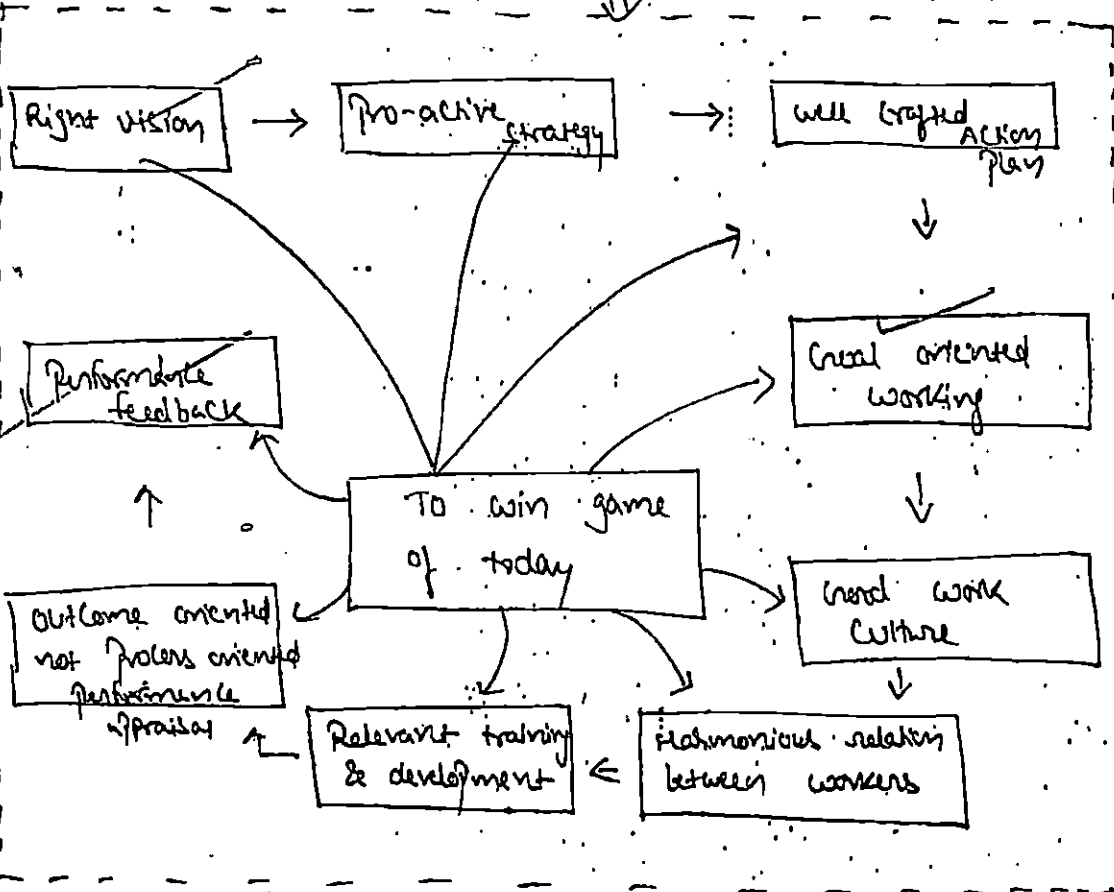
Certain core principles of sellers like determination, ~~action plan~~, well laid out strategy, always hold true. It can be considered as same wine in changed bottle.

Portrayals in movies of partition where a muslim is slaying and raping sikh's children & women and sikhs and doing the same on muslim community. Like a CADAR movie.

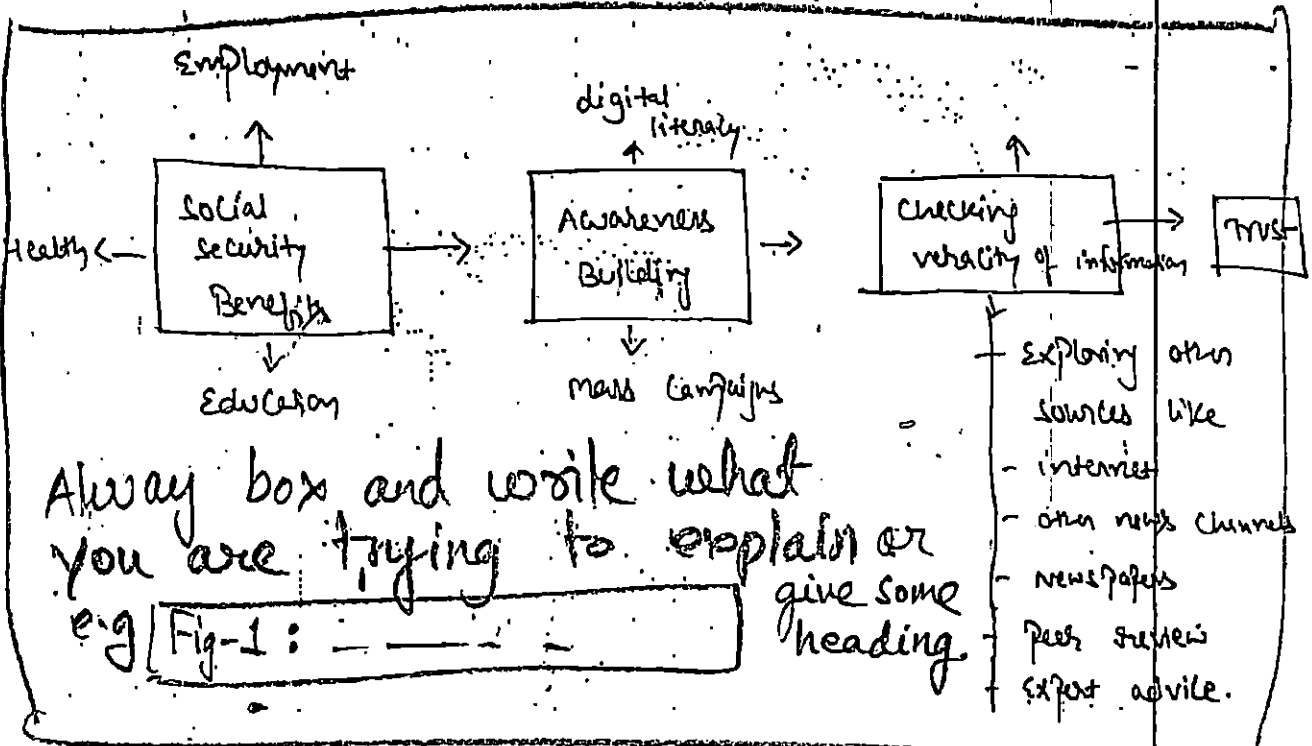
Really these portrayals puts things in a bitter taste.
