



ANCIENT AGES:

Man was one of the more fortunate animals on earth - blessed with intelligence, power of speech and rational thinking, he was way above the rest of species.

Instead of using these qualities for a harmonious living, he started making space for his hat, his food, and his living.

He discovered fire, so killed animals for food.

He discovered wheel, so domesticated horse.

He discovered agriculture, so occupied the land for self sustenance.

Reason:

At that point in time, human population was in its infancy and the effect of such activities hardly had any impact on existing population. Moreover, those early men would

MEDIEVAL RIES

European society in 13th-15th centuries saw the age of Renaissance - where the spirit of reason and inquiry ~~and adventure~~ led to

Industrialisation was the defining factor for entering into modernity → setting up factories, producing, generating wastes, disposing of it in open, and again producing were order of the day.

Rampant economic growth led to increasing industrialisation; it prompted other countries to also adopt path of industrialisation as sure shot way of developing the economy.

It was only in mid-20th century, that the London Smog of 1952 made people and leaders sit up and think about the impact of their activities on environment. It led to closing down of all economic activities for 4 whole days, because the whole city turned black with smoke.

It took another two decades for Stockholm Convention 1972 to happen, where for the first time, the impact of economic over production and over exploitation of resources was discussed. By 1987, the Bourland Committee report came up with the definition of Sustainable Development "judicious use of resources, to meet the needs of present generation, while keeping in mind the needs of future generations."

Gradually, the mindset was accepting

in that humans have been ruthlessly
exploiting nature and its resources over
centuries — and now, the ill effects
have finally begun.

WORLD WIDE CONSCIOUSNESS

This led to a world wide consciousness
effort to emphasize among industrialists,
world leaders and people, to slow down,
if not reduce the excessive over production.

In the wake of such consciousness, various
international efforts like Kyoto Protocol,
Doha Development Agenda — Rio + 20 and
now Paris Climate Change Conference were
held.

But even today, the pollution continues
to exist, the environmental concerns lost.

WHY?

There are various factors involved here -

- lack of strict penal laws on environmental damage - lack of accountability

CURRENT CHANGES

To overcome these challenges, the existing legal structure, the law and the institutions have all undergone a change.

There are special environmental courts, e.g. National Green Tribunal in India, whose mandate is to ensure no violation of environmental laws.


