Social stigma of early marriage deters the career progress of most girl children. Even in this era of widespread education and liberty, 47% of girls in India get married within age of 18. Parents marry their girls soon to relieve themselves of economic burden. The girl becomes financially dependent on her spouse and is left with no choices to make for herself.

The root cause here is the gender inequality which makes people see a girl child inferior to a boy. But times are changing, women have started defeating patriarchal tendencies. Lots more need to be done to bring more women climb the career ladders. What else be done?

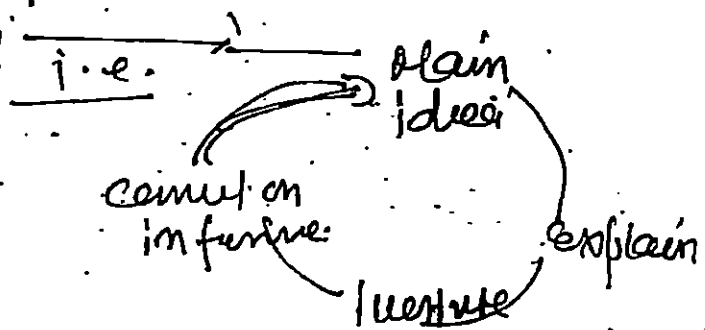
