EDUCATING THE MIND WITHOUT EDUCATING THE HEART IS NO EDUCATION AT ALL

Educating the mind without educating the heart is dangerous and dreadful, on the other hand educating the heart without educating the mind is weak and useless. It means both are complementary and supplementary to each other.

Today European countries on most parameters are ahead of developing countries; because of heavy investment in education. During 1750s, they invested heavily in educating the mind for INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION and colonized the whole world, and now they are investing heavily in value-based education to take their civilization to different level.

Educating the mind can increase the intellectual abilities and bring efficiency, effectiveness, cost-benefit analysis, optimal utilization of resources etc. but can't bring values like Justice, Equality, Reverence, Morality, Compassion, Empathy etc.

Remarks

In the subsequent paragraphs we would analyse why educating the mind and heart is important in various fields like Administration, Medical, Science, Business, Politics, Society, History, Environment etc.

In administration, education of mind will give knowledge of planning, Organising, Coordinating, Budgeting; Efficiency etc. But this in itself is not sufficiently especially in a country like India where we are struggling with poverty, malnutrition, inequality, etc. In these dire situations, we need Administrators with heart. To take a few examples of Administrators with heart — Prashant Nair is a District Collector of Kozhikode district in state Kerala where there is a problem of poverty and malnutrition. Through an innovative plan (education of mind) — Operation Salaimani he introduced the concept of food coupons within the Kozhikode district can take the coupon and have food in the affiliated restaurant with same food as is offered to rich person. (Education of heart).

Remarks

Medical science is a field where doctors are treated like God. In this field education of mind require knowledge of different fields like medicine, surgery, homeopathy, allopathy etc. But this is not sufficient at all.

For e.g. An Indian woman, Savita Halappanavar, a dentist, died in Norway due to pregnancy related problems. This was not due to lack of education of mind but education of heart.

Similarly, if we take the field of science and technology, education of mind require basic knowledge of Physics, chemistry, and fundamental laws of nature. But the big question is, education of mind without education of heart bring disasters in society and can be a threat to mankind.

For e.g. Osama Bin Laden was a great intellect in this field but he lacked the education of heart. Similarly A.O Khan is a great scientist of Pakistan but he lacked education of heart due to which he sold the formula to ~~make~~ make a

nuclear bomb to different nations which can be ended up in the hands of terrorist and extremists.

Some years ago, business was synonymously used with profit motive only. Business education traditionally was equated with education in how to make profits? (education of mind). Now the landscape has changed, business started thinking about Business ethics, ethical business, long-term business, multistakeholders approach etc. Business which lack the values approach etc. Business which lack the values will not survive for long. As rightly pointed out by great Henry Ford - A business which makes nothing but money is a poor kind of business. These lines clearly show education of mind and heart both are necessary in business.

Foreign Satyam - An information Technology company vanished due to lack of education of heart.

Similarly, political education requires both education of mind and heart. Here education of mind means knowledge about different concepts like Democracy, Participation, electoral process etc.

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Our politicians does not have a heart except a very few. If they have a heart, they should have by this time eradicated the corruption and criminalisation in politics. Election Commission and Law Commissions time and again sent proposals to the govt but those recommendations were never discussed in the Parliament.

The Law Commission sent proposals on "Reforms of Electoral Laws" in their 170th report. And EC had sent 47 proposals including those of "election expenses", "election campaign", "reforms".

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Education of heart requires knowledge and implementation of values like Justice, related to Equality, transparency, morality etc. in Dec, 2017. for various scenes like 2G scam; But none of these coal scam, Adarsh Society scam etc were all due to lack of education of heart. It was discussed.

To provide political education in the values, now a days Parliament which is based on we listen about Code of Conduct, Code of Ethics, Ray Dharma etc. These are present in required to realize the values minister says in enshrined in our preamble like Justice, liberty, equality etc. In the month of July, 2011, that E.C. failed to curb the spending.

In social fields names like Mahatma Gandhi ji, Mother Teresa etc. worked for marginalized, poor, women, scheduled caste to uplift them and bring them to the mainstream due to education of heart. Similarly, Mother Teresa worked day-in-day-out for poor people due to empathy, compassion etc which are nothing but education of heart/conscience. You can also go for recent & modern

Remarks Examples from India where these people have worked for amrits. Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, the Missile man, might have got the provision to build the missile as he had new the Pakistan and CHINESE waging India. He felt the need for securing Indian Borders. Now due to his efforts on missile, the CHINESE are not able to cross Doklam and to wage war against India.

Neurological Science also maintained that education of heart is based on emotions, conscience etc. is as much important as education of mind.

Similarly, Education of mind and heart is required for the sustainable development also; many times, we debate whether growth is important or environment is important. A person with education of both mind and heart will go for the balanced and holistic middle path; it with inclusive or sustainable development.

In engineering field, great Winstow Taylor applied education of mind gave to the world Scientific management. But this Scientific management treated humans like cog in the wheel. means dehumanising approach due to lack of education of heart.

Sri. G.V. Sridharan, who visualised the transport problem of Delhi gave metro to Delhi. As on date Delhi without metro would have

been a hell with traffic jams and could have been an unlivable city.

Now, the GOI has decided to provide metro to all cities whose population is more than 10. Lakhs.

So, education of heart is required to bring compassion, empathy, justice, equity; in society for vulnerable sections like women, aged persons and children. This is required to bring down the communal clashes, ethnic violence, regionalism and bring the feeling of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam (whole earth is our family).

To bring back the glory and greatness of ancient India where foreign travellers used to say some wonderful things about India and its people - like Indians were devoid of dacoity, untouchability and were largely honest people, we need to build a strong value-based education system in which education of mind will make us world economic power and education of heart will make us CIVILIZATION to be emulated. For this - family system, society, schools, Government, Civil Society organizations need to make collective efforts.

THE INDIAN DEMOCRACY HAS FALLEN INTO THE "MORASS OF POWERPLAY AND THE POLITICIANS HAVE BECOME "GAMERS" RATHER THAN "SERVANTS" OF NATION AND ITS PEOPLE.

Mahatma Gandhiji has once said that "POLITICS WITHOUT PRINCIPLES" is one of the social sins. It means in a nation where political setup and parties within it, if devoid of values like justice, transparency, participation etc can bring lots of social hardships.

In the recent decades, these lines of Mahatma Gandhiji seems to be true in case of Indian Democracy. Indian Democracy has seen some low points in these decades. In the subsequent paragraphs we would analyse how India from an abode of democracy and its principles, ~~has~~ recently seen some of the lowest points.

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In the pre-Vedic society of the institutions like VIDHAYA etc. which were democratic like SABHA, SAMITI, etc. In these institutions, the people involved worked for the whole village, clan and we can say they acted as SERVANTS to the society. As far as democracy and its principles is concerned, India has seen authoritarian rules after that very good introduction.

After Independence in 1947, India adopted the REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY. In this type of setup; people's representatives are supposed to be the SERVANTS of the people. True initial decades, our politicians acted as the role models and not only saved the nascent democracy but evolved it in a manner which set an example for the whole world to adopt. Politicians like Sh. Jawaharlal Nehru, Vallabhbhai Patel etc. were the believers in democracy and its principles. They worked with the

support of opposition, healthy discussions in the parliament, regular sittings, discussions devoid of partisanship and for the social cause were the norms in early 1950s and 1960s. [even considers the opinion of the opposition and keep informed of all affairs. In the late 1960s and

1970s, Indian democracy has seen morsels of powerplay. [for e.g. Entry of Criminals in the political arena based on muscle and money power has vitiated the whole fabric of our democracy. This is called as Criminalisation of politics and falsification of criminals.

As per one of the estimates 33% of the members of parliament in the previous Lok Sabha were facing criminal charges. Recently as per the survey of the A.D.R (Association of Democratic Reforms) an NGO (Non-Governmental Organisation), 76% of the members of legislative assembly in Bihar state are facing the

In the late 1950s, the central government has dismissed the first Finance Minister of democratically elected Communist government in the world, that is publicly mentioned in the Kerala state. It was based on Article 356. To dismiss the elected government for political gains is nothing but control the treasury of India. democracy and Black Money misuse of power.

After 1987, Indian democracy has seen the coalition politics. To form the government at the centre or at state the majority party use the money power and horse trading.

members of parliament openly showed the cash used for the horse trading. In this way politicians hence become "gamers" rather than the servants of the nation. If they treat their profession as an END and not as a MEANS to serve the people of their own country.

Indian democracy has seen this power play and gamers due to Illiteracy of people and their elected entry poverty of criminal-minded persons in parliament, lack of options before the people etc. Lots of steps has been taken by the institutions like ELECTION COMMISSION, institutions like A.D.R (Association of Democratic Reforms), PUCL (People Union for Civil Liberties) etc.

In 2002, after the Supreme Court judgement in A.D.R case, now it is compulsory for each aspirant to declare his criminal antecedents and his and his family wealth.

In another Supreme Court Judgement, NOTA (None of the Above) option was introduced to give people power to reject the undeserving candidates. Though there is no legal backing behind this step but it will act as moral deterrent.

N.N. Vohra Committee disclosed the unholy nexus between the Politician, Businessmen and Bureaucrat which is nothing but mosats. To stop this lots of steps were taken by government recently forcing Benami Transaction Act, 2016. It was notified after 25 years when it was firstly enacted.

Lots of demands were raised to amend the PoCA (Prevention of Corruption Act) and to notify the LOKPAL ACT, 2014.

To curb the unholy nexus of business men and politicians recently in the budget lots of steps were taken. For eg. limit of cash deposit was reduced from 10000 to 2000, introduction of Electoral Bonds, etc.

To curb the invisible money play in the election, there is a need to give more powers to the election commission as were demanded by it time and again. Apart from the limit or cap on the individual expenditure, there is a need to put cap on the political parties.

Supreme Court through its judgement ordered to make fast-track courts for giving judgment within year against the standing members is a right step in the right direction.

To make our democracy effective and participative, 73rd and 74th amendment act were enacted. According to the Manmohan Singh Aiyer report, 2013 due to powerplay and vested interest of the politicians at the central and state levels these democratic bodies are failing to their jail. To make them participative, effective we need to implement the ARC II recommendations.

For 2F, (functionaries, functionaries and finance) needs to be devolved to make them true self government as desired by Mahatma Gandhi and rightly depicted in Article 40.

To realise the true potential of our democracy, we need to focus on Participative Democracy rather than representative democracy, through more effective implementation of 73rd, 74th Constitutional amendment act, RTI (Right to information), Social Audit, Citizen charters etc.

To conclude, Indian Democracy requires more and more participation of people, internal democracy within political parties, healthy debates and discussions in temples of democracy along with better and effective implementation of legislations like LOKPAN ACT, Lokayukta Act, PoCA (Prevention of corruption Act) etc. This way we can set the example for the world, that Indian democracy is not only the largest democracy but with values and morality as well.


