happiness would connote peace of mind, joys, - utility, Contentment.


Unfortunately with the passage of time our thought process has given a different meaning to happiness. It is now more measured in terms of goods and commodities one can possess and their respective monetary value.

People 'over-produce' pollution because they are not paying for the cost of dealing with it.

The greatest threat to our planet is nation that
somebody else will save it.

Individual's tendency to pollute the Mother Nature even beyond carrying capacity of ecosystem and above its replacement levels is basically premised on the fact that they are not subjected for compensation directly into monetary terms.

In other words their Polluting Behaviors entail from the notions that they are not required to incur expenses for its disposal, treatment.

It is a well accepted notion that more often than not people behave responsibly only when their actions are correlated with certain accountability. And this accountability may result into compensation or penalties for

their erroneous behaviour.

Control Board for~~ However, unfortunately we do not have any kind of responsibility and accountability fixing mechanism for those people who pollute over their permissible limits.

Owing to this these people has an inclination to pollute the ecosystem beyond its recovery levels.

At individual level observations can be made from various urban 'hotspots' of pollution like slums & squatter homes proliferating in solid waste and dumping the garbage in the open field. Similarly the so called 'elite' classes of people are dumping non-biodegradable E-waste, plastic waste.

These unsustainable way of polluting is basically attributed to the fact that these individuals are not required to compensate and pay for their treatment and disposal.

on similar footing inferences can be gathered from the untenable activities of various corporate bodies.

Corporate bodies use the water from the nearby natural sources for their industrial activities like dying, washing, etc and dump the polluted water and the other garbage in the nearby lakes and ponds. Vellaiyur lake, which falls a severe problem of Eutrophication, is a

case in point. It is the River Cauvery - Number of municipalities in the river as drainage outlet.

Hence, irresponsible activity of pollution is

swallowing the recovery levels of ecosystems.

Had there been any mechanism whereby these corporate entities would have required to pay

for their 'own production' of pollution these

lakes would not have meeting under their

existential crisis.

On similar note of insights can be gained from the activities of various nations who dump their wastes into the global commons

The South Asian Tiger Countries which has seen some tremendous and impreffing increase

in their Economic Pursuit. However in the process has lead to deterioration of the water body - Indian Ocean in this case.

Similar is the case with developed countries like Canada & U.S.A who are recklessly engaged in their economic pursuit and in

the process subjugating the ecosystem sanctity of Atlantic ocean to their economic aspirations.

Hence, had there been any mode by which these countries could have been subjected to pay for their reckless, irresponsible & unsustainable mode of working the Blue Planet would have suffered such impairment of its ecosystem.

Hence, had there been ~~a~~ methods whereby these people could have been taxed or penalised for our producing the pollution & thereby for its treatment, world would not have been pushed to the brink of dramatic climate change.

fact they do not have to bear the cost of 1% treatment.

However, it should be noted that though directly people might not get impacted, affected, penalized, fined for their erroneous & irresponsible behaviour, however, they are subjected to non-monetary loss, qualitative cost.

This loss or cost can be seen in the wide prevalence of diseases like pulmonary infection, cardiac arrest, cholera, typhoid, malaria and many others. The exponential increase in diseases can be attributed to the unsustainable increase in Pollution of the ecosystem.

Various indicators like Air quality index, WHO report indicated that the pollution levels in cities are touching record high levels. Last 3 years as per WHO has seen the highest temperatures ~~with~~ ~~so far~~.
