

As per Census 2011, 31.8% of our population lives in Urban areas, rest of our population is living in

Rural areas with ^{only} 31.8% of urbanisation, our urban areas are highly congested. Urban infrastructures such as water and electricity supply, Health Services, educational Services, solid and liquid waste management, public transport etc are crashing with rising higher demands due to migration of people from rural to urban areas.

There are also problems of traffic congestion, air pollution

increasing of number of slums, sanitation and hygiene in urban areas. Urban crimes are also growing day by day.

problem of unemployment, disguised employment and informal employment is also rising in urban areas.

Though smart city could help alleviate some problems by creation of new infrastructure but real issue of unsustainable and unmanageable rural-urban migration will not be solved.




