Terrorism is an act of terror done by a single person or a group of people to achieve narrow political or economic gain. Terrorism is not a new phenomenon, it has been happening since long. We can see it in USA. There were groups known as KKK, etc. In Europe, British, Irish Republican Army and Union Brigade, they engaged in terrorist activities. ✓

Environment also gets affected

Environmental terrorism. As environment consist of air surrounding it has toxic effect. But let us restrict ourselves in terms of terrestrial and marine environment. Due to high emission of CO₂ and other pollutants environment is getting affected and both North-South Nations are engaged in it.

It is to be noted that USA, China and Europe are 3 big emitters of CO₂. Because of another aspect of environmental terrorism comes is in terms of marine ecosystem. Industrialised nations dump their house waste and factory waste into river and ocean, that is affecting marine ecosystem.

According to IAD report by 2050 there will be more plastic in ocean than fish.

If we take the environment as a bigger platform, there is an aspect of piracy in oceans.

Recent example of a man was lynched in U.P. due to alleged keeping of beef in home, This Malda riots in Bengal, Assamese cum Jorhat to leave Bangalore, Killing of Mr. Narendar Dhabolkar who raised voice against superstition, all the above example shows that terrorism is prevalent in our society also. Which is against the ideal of brotherhood, Comradre that are enshrined in our constitution.

With societal terrorism cultural terrorism emerges that is hatred against other cultures that leads to hate crime. In today's world there is an emergent sense of protectionism and rising xenophobic tendencies. Cultural terrorism can be easily seen, ex. including killing of

From above discussion we can see there are lots of dimension of terrorism, Now we will shed some light on various countries which are victims of terrorism, or are they harboring terrorist?

~~Right~~ "There is a country in our neighborhood who is mother ship of terrorism, and it is only league of terrorism. This was the reply given by MS Enam Hambhir in UN Council, from India in their right to reply.

There is no doubt that Pakistan has been harboring terrorist, even if they don't accept it. Many reports be it: USA report on 9-11 Commission on India's report on 26-11 both corroborate the fact. And the living example is killing of most wanted terrorist by American at Pakistan soil in Abbottabad.

Because of terrorism Pakistan has become a failed state. And there is very little law and order. Civilian leadership is weak and to perpetuate violence on Pakistan, ~~or~~ especially nuclear has army to protect them. In Pakistan army has a nation. And in Pakistan you don't join army to defend the country you join it to save the country.

But ~~it is~~ still USA has been giving military and economic aid to Pakistan under Henry Kissinger Berman act. In last 10 yrs Pak received approx \$33 Bn dollar from USA. From which \$24 Bn was under administration of Mr Obama. It shows that you are supporting terrorism but let us not forget that chicken always come home to roost.

And USA also supported their Mujahideen and when Soviet invaded Afghanistan USA was discriminating in good - Bad terrorist. There is no such thing as good or bad terrorist a terrorist is a terrorist.

In this context when Pakistani ISI was training Taliban training of using them against India in case of war. But later not so many years ago. They started to attack Pak school and mosques.

There were many attacks ex. is Paris attack, Belgium attack, London Bombing 2012 and Peshawar school attack where 144 children were killed. So quite Mrs Hillary Clinton can't keep snake in your backyard and expect them only to bite your neighbor!

These terrorist use various methods such as suicide bombings, sleeper cells, RDX lone wolf attack and now a days cyber attack.

Just like ~~an~~ Pakistan, China is ~~not~~ also facing terrorist-crisis in their Xinjiang region that is north to 1st state. India also apprehension because that can cause ~~an~~ instability to already tense J&K and spill over effect to other state.

In Russia also there is Chechnya province where armed terrorism is causing problem that has hampered their economy, many act of violence as well as spreading fear & hate among civilian.

In Balkan region, there is Bosnia Herzegovina, which is causing trouble.

In Colombia, there is Revolutionary Armed Force of Colombia (FARC) - But recently FARC & the civilian govt came to a peace clause and so the old civil war was ended so that people can live in peace and prosper.

In Palestine & Israel, there is Hamas, Hezbollah for some they are military of country for some they are terrorist - spreading fear among civilian.

Remarks

By seeing all the countries and their terrorist problem, let us for a while focus on India. India has been advocating and asking the world to support him on ~~the~~ ending terrorism but the world community never listened and especially USA pushed aside it by saying that it is India's own law and order problem. Until 9-11 happens, then people realise that terrorism is a terrorism there is no good or bad. And USA started their war on terrorism. Either you are with us or against us

In India there is few legal remedies to deal with terrorism activities that are TADA act, Unlawful Activities Prevention act (UAPA) and Prevention of Terrorism act (POTA). India have had few instances of terrorism, few worth mentioning are 1992 Bombay Blast (termed as Black Friday), flight hijack ~~in~~ by Samir Khan, Masood Azhar & 26/11 and recent attacks on Uri and Pathankot air base.

India has launched various operations to deal with terrorism and rescue the diaspora from foreign nations like operation PARIAE, operation SANKATMOCHAN, Op. AIRLIFT. India also helps Indian origin littoral states like Seychelles to monitor against piracy & terrorism by providing them defence support & position & PT maritime reconnaissance aircraft (patrolling vessel)

Remarks

To deal with cross border terrorism, Parliamentary Committee on defence set up timeline for effective comprehensive integrated Border management (CIBM) that would involve wired electric fencing of Indo pacific border. And soldiers would be armed border with 24x7 night-vision cameras, motion detectors and infrared cameras.

Also to stop terrorism, India is supporting the construction and development programme in Afghanistan like Salma dam and Afghan parliament.

But still the world community that is involved in negotiation formed Quadrilateral Coordination group (C4G) that involve USA, Afghanistan, Pakistan and China. But not India.

To stop terrorism India also engage with many countries in joint naval exercise, military exercise like Yudhyabhyas & Shatrujit with USA, INDRA with Russia, INCHSMILES with China and MALABAR with Japan & USA together.

To stop terrorism now is the time to promote a global consensus that India has been advocating. India is advocating for comprehensive convention on international terrorism (CCT) that is the need of the hour and also ban the funding of terrorist organisations. This can only be possible by the help of UN and P5 members.

They substantiate their viewpoint with help of few examples.

Abraham Lincoln, had a breakdown at the age of 40. He lost his companion and also lost 4 US presidential elections but he didn't stop thinking big and local knowledge happen new. He is the most popular American president and he contributed to abolish slavery in USA.

on the line of Gandhi, In Africa Nelson Mandela also united the mass and had a big vision of freedom of African people, that led to the African freedom movement. And people got liberated from Apartheid.

The main proponent of thinking big is India that is necessary to analyse when India got freedom in 1947. ~~At that time~~ she was facing poverty, unemployment, communal tensions, no resources, and other issues. But our leaders prevail they had big thinking ~~and~~ reimagining India. 1st prime minister Pt Nehru had the vision of India in his mind ~~at~~ the time of independence when he gave the speech that "India is at the stroke of the midnight hour. India is awake."

Remarks

Since then India started her journey thinking big in terms of agriculture. India being nation of 64% rural people whose main occupation is subsistence agriculture, so India started green revolution for self-reliance of seed and farm produce that made India world exports of Rice and wheat. Later on India started mechanisation and other initiatives to promote agriculture.

Thinking big in terms of economy, India was left bleeding in 1947, crunch of all wealth in 2017, 70 yrs later India is among top 10 world economy standing tall at \$ 2 Trn USD. Amongst the global slowdown in world market, India is held as a bright spot by world Bank and IMF.

Thinking big in terms of security, since the experience of colonialism was imprinted on everyone's mind Indian leaders had a vision of powerful India and they developed India's defence capacity and started investing in various fields including nuclear. India currently spends \$ 57 Bn USD on its defence Budget. In order to think big India has to have nuclear weapons and that India did after her 1st test in 1974 and then again in

At 1998, they made India a definite nuclear power India thought big and realise their world's understand the argument of power rather than the power of argument.

India thought big in terms of S&T and the main proponent of it was then PM. Rajiv Gandhi he had a vision of advanced India he started to push for S&T developments. We have now become very much advanced in S&T, India has transformed from the land of snake charmers to mouse money.

In space exploration also India made big name and few recent happenings like launch of 104 satellites by PSLV simultaneously launch of Moon mission flights have made the name even bigger. New projects like scramjet engine, reusable launch vehicle and cryogenic engine ^{are} also being developed.

~~Now~~ Not 3 or 4 decades ago no body would have mentioned India's and advanced technology in some breadth. But now the world is asking India to send their satellite in space. This show the power of thinking big.

Remarks

Thinking big in terms of socio. economy. At the time of 1947 Indian literacy rate was 18% and socioeconomic indicators were at all time low. Now India has made an exponential progress like literacy is at 74%. MMR is at 167/1 lakh, IMP is at 41/1000.

These indicators are good with respect to 1947. But still with world average India still has to make big. For instance avg global literacy is 85% and India missed target of 140 MMR and 29 IMP in Millennium development goal till

But India is on the right path. To make ²⁰¹⁵ big ~~from~~ think big each and every strata of society has to be moving for the ENS and LIn / poor and tribal people

India launched various initiative like Skill development, Digital India, Make in India, Startup ^{standup} India, special scheme for particularly vulnerable Tribal group, new min of Entrepreneurship that would help them think big and achieve big

Many project schemes also launched like Nai Roshni, Udaan, Tyaswini project, UDAN, Aajeevika, HIMAYAT, Nandanam, Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojna, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao etc

This shows that think big corresponds to think big for everyone. And specially half of our humanity that is women. According to UN (1980 report) "Women constitute half the world's population, they work $\frac{2}{3}$ of world's work but they receive $\frac{1}{10}$ of world's income and they own only $\frac{1}{100}$ of world's property".

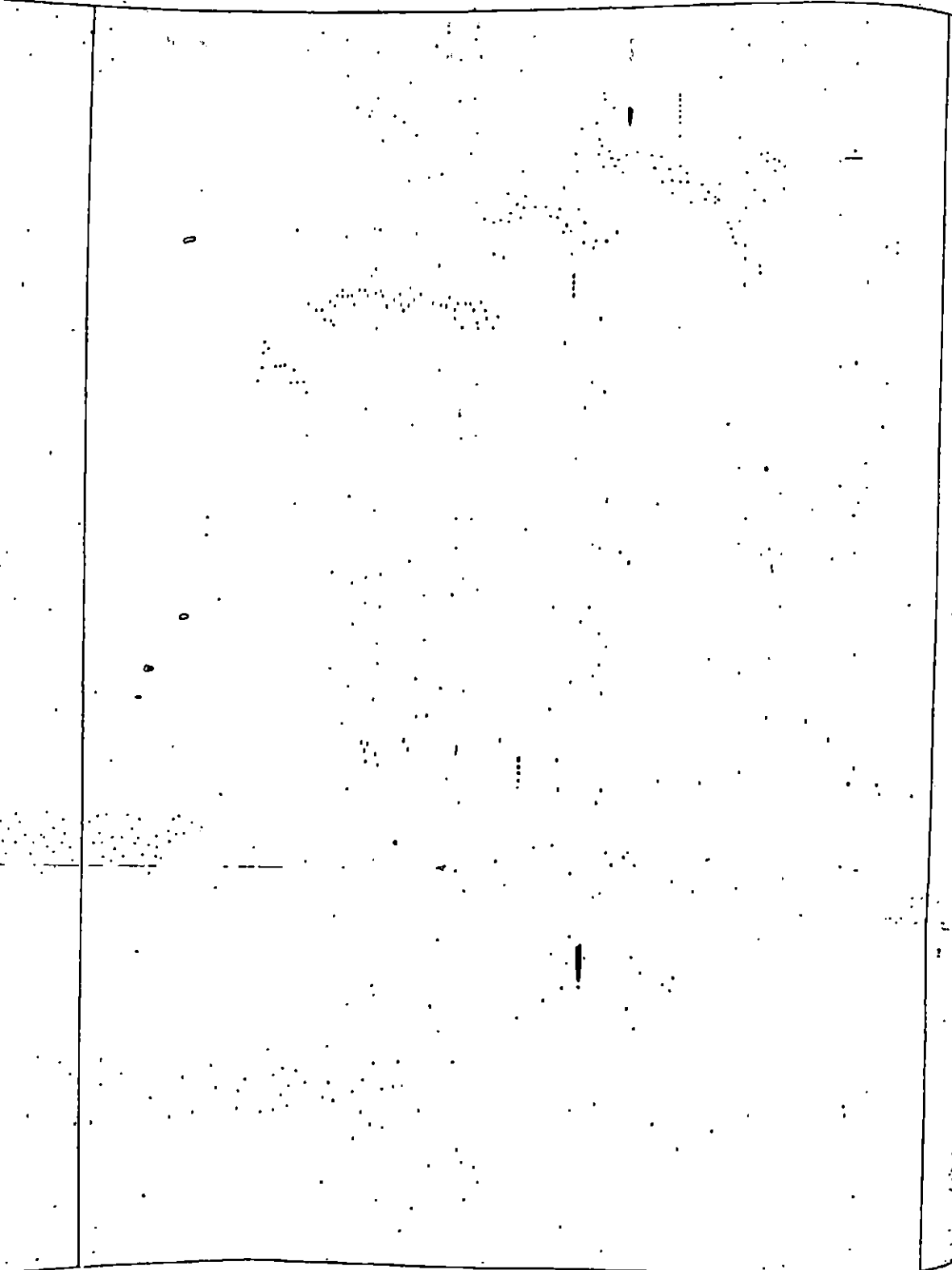

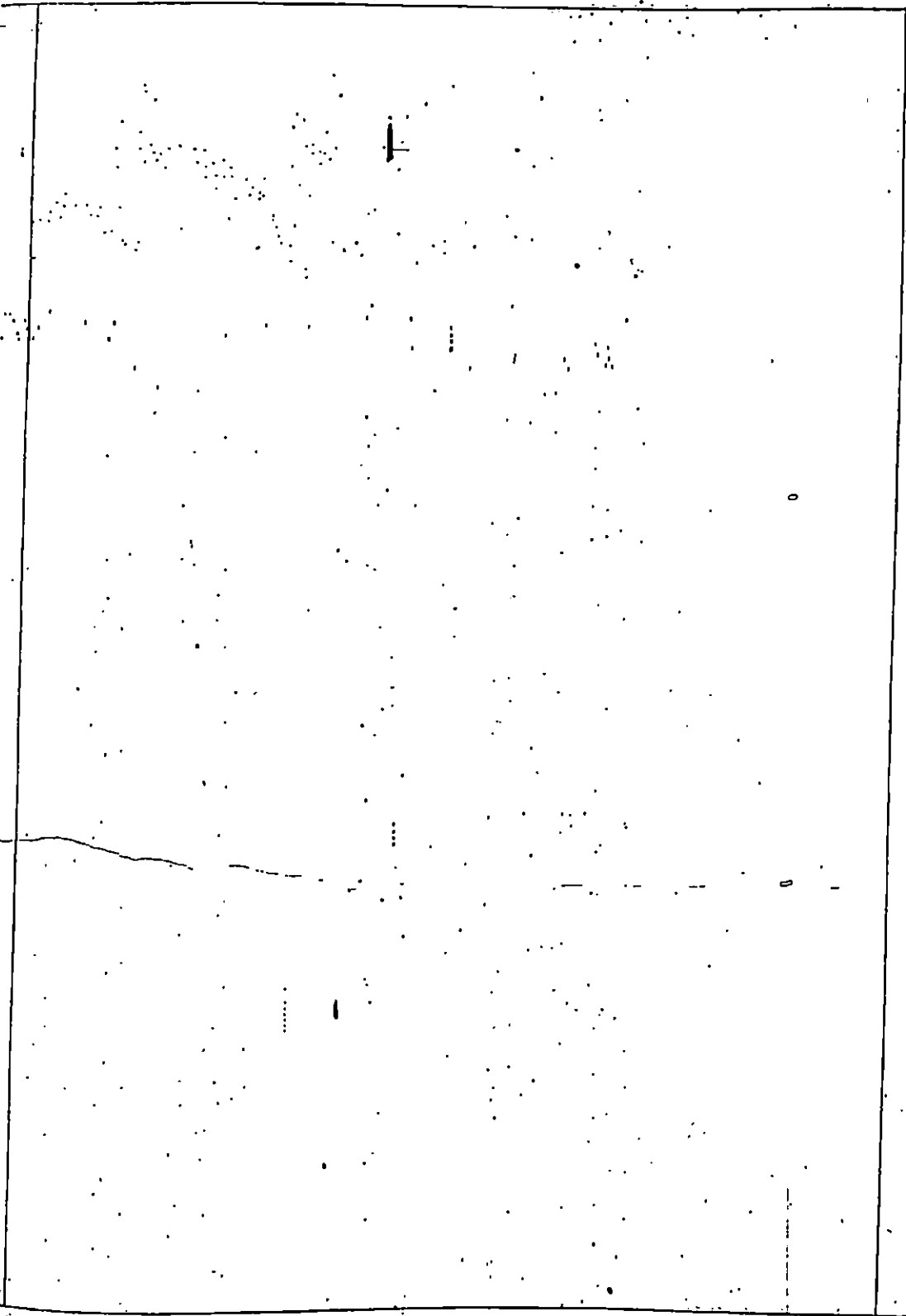

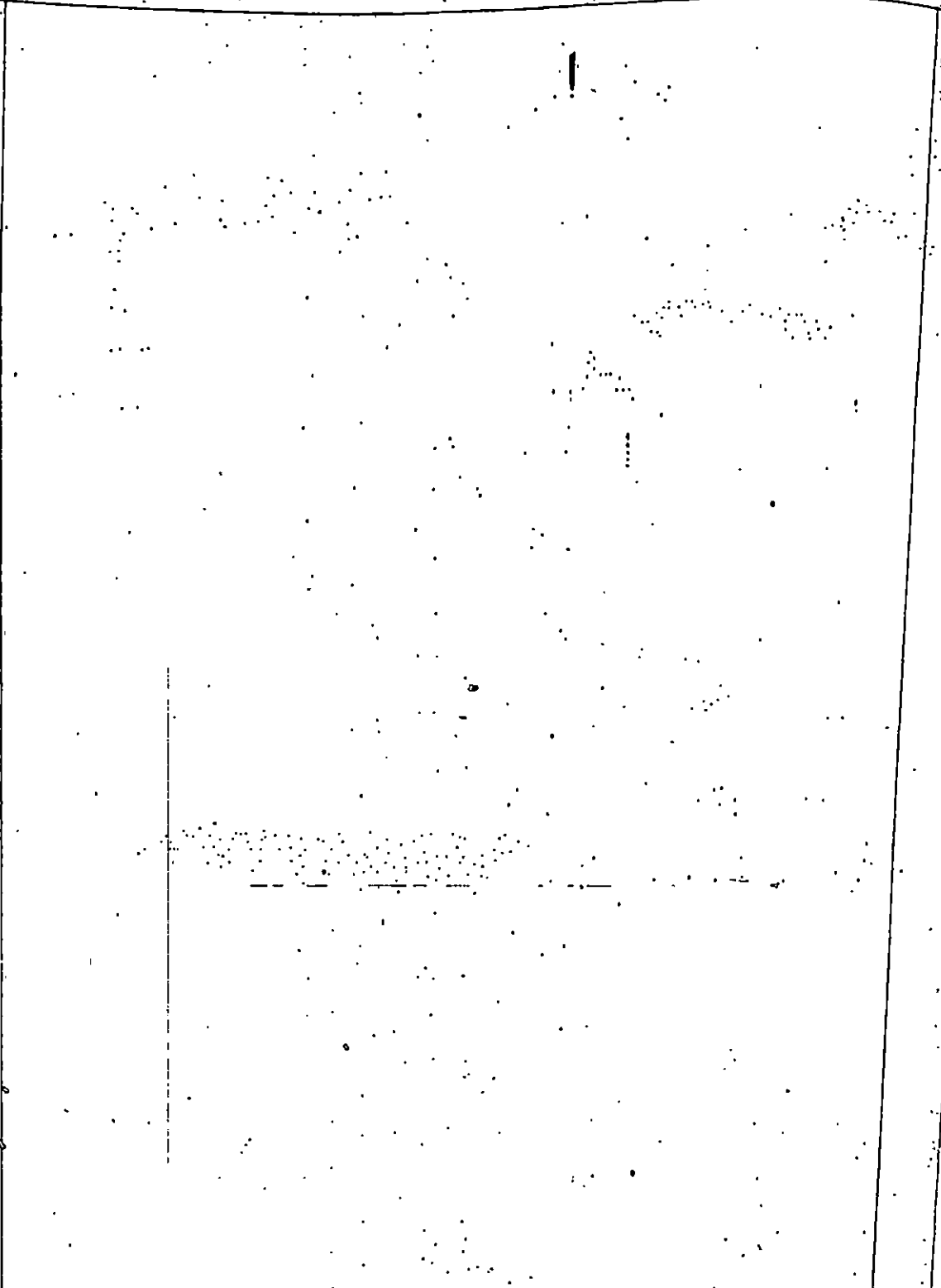
