We are proud Indians, we proud our culture, our history, our education, we proud on our economy. I, as an Indian too proud of being a citizen of the country ~~who~~ which has 5000 years old civilizations, where the great religions of the world like Hinduism, Buddhism, Jainism etc too birth, which is place where '0' was first ~~discovered~~ invented. We have a lot of things to boast of but every morning when I read newspaper, my pride starts to faint, it makes me feel whether we are heading our country to progressive path or not.

As a nation we have progressed from being an infantile democracy (after independence) to a mature world be global power but the most question is whether our society too shows that maturity. Society is benchmark of progress of any nation. It is also true that no society is perfect.

but if look at our society we could see how much is there which is need to be reformed. Every day, newspaper is full of incidents of rape, murder, intolerant activities, statistics giving information about our poor social indicators.

Every Majority of us are outrageous for what is happening around us. We show our dissent, on social media, on newspapers and society meetings but this not enough. In this essay we will see how just showing annoyance will not be enough for solving our society's failures, how a real and focused attention is need of the hour.

A society is a wide term that encompasses its population (child, youth, women^{etc}), including every section its institutions, its relationship among various sections, its relation with other aspects like economical and political which is itself a part of society. We will see how the society is suffering from various ills that needs urgent attention.

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Our children are ~~one~~ ^{among} of the poorest, weakest children of the world. According to National Family Health Survey, 37% of the children in India are stunted. The level of malnutrition is ^{one of the} highest here comparable to sub Saharan countries. Besides this education status is too poor. According to ASER survey class 5 student is not able to read class 2 text books.

These are ^{not} only problem. The evil of child labour is rampant here. Child sexual abuse cases can be heard every now & then. All these are our society's failure to provide safe & secure childhood to our children.

Similarly women are considered essential part of our society, she women composed 49% of our population. But she is most vulnerable. Right from at the womb till the tomb she face various injustices like female foeticide, domestic violence, less education, sexual abuse, economic dis-empowerment. This is our society's incapability to ensure safety to the women.

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Similarly our youth faces problem of unemployment and skill famine. Our senior citizens the feeling of dejection and economic insecurity, disrespect from own children. Besides these sections we even not recognize some sections are rightful citizens of our country like the disabled differently abled or transgenders or to be more inclusive LGBTIAQ+ sections. They most of the time discarded by our society.

If we talk about the institutions, the rampant child marriages across the country shows the shameful face of our society. Dowry, Domestic violence etc associated with this great institutions of our society. Besides this derogatory practice of selling girls as bride is another grave side.

On the other hand, the institution of caste that has perpetuated untouchability from centuries still is not able to recover from its past. The cases of atrocities on delites, discrimination with them

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Considering them second class citizens is still prevalent. The death of Rohit Verma again started the debate.

~~So~~ As a citizen we are having a duty to have scientific temper. But this takes a back seat when the women or men are burnt on being suspected as the witches. It shows how our society rather than being progressive going back to the regressive practices.

Other is the rising intolerance in our society, communalism, regionalism etc are ~~not~~ overpowering our ~~sense of~~ feeling of unity and brotherhood. The cases of cow vigilantism, mob lynching etc are everyday events. This is also a great evil that our society needs to get rid of. The communalist violence is not what Mahatma Gandhi has expected of India after 70 years of independence.

Our education and health sectors again shows the level of apathy on our

part. There is still a thought prevalent that educated girls would make slave of their husband. This is when we have great examples of Kelpana Chawala, ~~and~~ Sarita Nehwal, Anandhathi Bhattacharya, etc.

Society also said to be forward when it do its duty towards the political institutions. We are still far apart from other countries in paying taxes, voting in elections (though we improved a lot in this), being a participatory citizen to make dream of citizen centric governance.

Corruption is one of the biggest ills of our society. It has grappled from lowest to highest rung. Not only bribe taken but bribe giver is happy to do so pay bribe. It is biggest blot on our society. We rank poor 76/168 countries in transparency international ranking. We all are against it, but the thing is we all are arm chair critic.

Example Temple entry is Shari Shignapur temple & making Triple talag unconstitutional.



History is mirror of any culture, any nation or any individual. Our history tells us how we advanced as a person, as a nation or as society or as a country. Our history is repository of our glorious past, our dreary time, our literature & all the great personalities that took birth. History shows how we get our present form (as being a predecessor of ape) as human history tells us that crisis that occur from time to time either leads to solution or catastrophe.

Our history backs billion of years back when our earth took birth due to changing cosmological events. After that may many species took birth & decayed, many eras have passed since but all can witness how crisis is the decisive factor of anything

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that is next to occur. It is also said in the Darwin's Evolution theory, that crisis leads to changes, for some it is solution in form of adaptation, for others it is catastrophe in form of decay. In this essay we will discuss how various events in history proves this fact that crisis either leads to solution or catastrophe.

At the dawn of civilization, ~~we~~ humans used to live in forests, hunting animals and struggling to survive. When the animals started hunting them at a great level they solved this crisis by finding the solution in form of FIRE. This was one of the first discoveries of man. Similarly when man started fighting with man and again there occurred crisis of life, we found the institution of society and family.

Earlier civilizations used to be isolated due to lack of facilities for ~~communication~~ communication. But with advancing time the need of various things that can't be produced or made at one's place started to be felt. This gave birth

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to TRADE. Trade between various civilizations though at miniscule level at start. We developed links to reach from one place to another. The Harappa civilization was said to do trade with the surrounding cultures and ~~mesopotamia~~ areas.

Then when we moved to later vedic, we found in history that there was huge crisis due to the rampant ~~teacher~~ in name of religion by the particular section of society. 15th century and the trade by controlled by powers of Turkey & Italy, the crisis occurred in western countries like Portugal, Spain etc. This led to the adventure of Columbus, Vasco d Gama etc that started searching for alternate routes to India, this led to discovery of America and India.

The crisis that was felt by the people of Europe during this period due to rampant corruption in religious functionaries and widespread superstitions led to Renaissance, reformation and scientific inventions like Copernican revolution. British industrial revolution in 18th century was also due to the crisis the ~~businesses~~ were facing there due to Businesses Indian imports.

Again coming to India, in the medieval period various social evils like child marriage, Sati etc took place. This perpetuated until the reformers took the mantle of opposing it. This led to ban over Sati on efforts of Raja Ram Mohan Ray.

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Similarly when the problems that were caused due to British colonialism in India reached to unbearable levels the solution is found in form of SWARAJ or POORNA SWARAJ that is independence. Our struggle against British gave birth to a new India that was a nation than just a territory.

In ^{recent} ~~modern~~ history various crisis led to various discoveries and inventions. The outbreak of various diseases encouraged men to work for their cure. This led to development of various vaccines and the ~~studies~~ ^[ex.-Ebola] we have made in medicine sector is due to the crisis we face from time to time.

Similarly the crisis of when various big countries were fighting each other over natural resources because of greed of money led them to start slave trade in which they made slave of African people and sell them. It started slave trade that lasted for more than 200 years and the catastrophe it caused was huge and deplorable.

The incessant industrial revolution that was reply to the widespread poverty and started as a progressive step only led to further inequalities and the other problem that show its faces in recent time is climate change that was also due to the rampant industrial development.

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World wars were the most catastrophic events of the history. The treaty of Versailles led to wide anguish in German people. This crisis rather than leading to solution, led to catastrophe in form of Nazism and fascism. This further showed its grave and brutal face in form of Holocaust.

Similarly the crisis of years of war that fatigued every nation (World War 2) but not Japan who was continually fighting with America led to the catastrophe of bombing by nuclear bomb on Japan by America whose results the current generation too bears in form of disabilities.

The crisis that Indian people in eastern part of country (West Bengal, Odisha etc) faced in form of poverty, unemployment, torched by landlord class led to the insurgency and finally Maoism that is the greatest threat to India's internal security till date.

 be. . . .

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
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
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
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
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
