Some people complained to the boss of the police officer that the concerned police officer is profestionally undeserging as he is not able to create terror among the perpetrators of the crime in the area. He should give thind order punishment to the stum dwellers so than they are deterred once for all from committing crimes. There is no use of attributes like being sensitive, human and kind in police service. The officer should be removed soon and replaced by another officer who uses his powers to scare the criminals. The boss of the police officer, however, finds' that the concerned officer is very dedicated and does his duty with honesty and sensitivity. Nevertheless he directs the concerned police officer to be tougher an the criminals so that grievances of the people are addressed soon. The concerned police officer introspects and he is very confused what to do. His lines of thought are given below. You have to consider all the options he is thinking and give reasons, which is the better course of action for him?
